Parenting Family Functioning Assessment

Master level therapists provide assessments in the family's home to determine strengths and needs. Assessments provide information regarding the family's current living situation, family functioning, treatment recommendations, and safety concerns.

Family Preservation

Flexible, community based services are provided to families at risk of having a child removed from the home. Services include parent skill training, behavior management, family therapy, and crisis intervention.

Individual & Family Therapy

Family therapists provide structured, goal oriented therapy to address many different issues. Services are provided in the community or in the individual or family's home.

Substance Abuse Assessment, Treatment, & Monitoring

Midwest staff conduct substance abuse assessments for individuals experiencing the adverse impact of alcohol and other drugs of abuse.

Outpatient substance abuse treatment includes individual counseling.

Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOP) is suited for adults that meet the clinical criteria for a less restrictive means of care than an inpatient setting. IOP includes group therapy & educational activities.

Evaluation/Testing Services

Complete and comprehensive assessments are conducted by Midwest staff to determine strengths, goals, and concerns in order to develop an individualized treatment plan for clients. Services include psychological testing, as well as educational or academic testing.

Behavior Management Services

Master level therapists provide services for families with issues in the home, school, or community that address the family's specific needs. Services are provided to help reach the goals outlined in the behavioral plan.

Psychological Consultations

Midwest provides psychological consultations to obtain specific information needed by the Child and Family Team to develop a comprehensive, individualized treatment plan.

Diagnostic and Evaluation Services

Diagnostic and assessment services are used to determine if physical, sexual, or emotional abuse or neglect is present in the household. Midwest staff conduct a variety of services including psychological evaluations, drug and alcohol testing, and the Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory, 2nd Edition.
