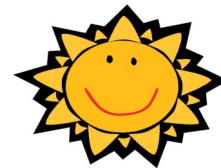
Midwest's residential habilitation services program are designed to apply high level standards of health, safety and respect as we help people with disabilities get as much out of life as possible.
